Preface

International Conference on Morphology and Digitisation

On the 7 and 8 July 2007, an International Conference on Morphology and Digitisation was held at the Free University of Berlin, covering several scientific fields in addition to linguistics in which the concept of morphology plays an important role. The topics of the papers ranged from basic linguistic subjects to the structure of clouds. The interdisciplinary character of the conference, together with the innovative combination of morphology and digitisation, enabled the participants to launch test baloons without the obligation of submitting articles for publication.
